



Prenatal Warning Signs and Symptoms

- A decrease in fetal movement
- Regular uterine contractions/cramps that do not lessen with rest and fluids
- Continuous watery fluid from your vagina
- Vaginal bleeding
- Abdominal pain which may or may not be accompanied by nausea, vomiting and/or diarrhea
- Persistent vomiting
- Fever above 100.4 F
- Sudden unexplained weight gain
- Severe or persistent headache
- Changes in vision including spots in front of your eyes
- Swelling of face and hands
- Decrease in urinary output
