- Weatherization Assistance Program: Enables reduced bills by making households more energy efficient. Call: (518)-474-5700
- Emergency Rental Assistance Fund (ERAP): Economic relief to those at risk of homelessness or housing instability. Call: (844)-691-7368

Home Energy Assistance Program (HEAP)

A federally funded program that helps low-income individuals heat and cool their homes. HEAP consists of 5 components:

- **1** Regular HEAP: Yearly benefits to assist in paying for home heating.
- 2 Clean and Tune Benefit: Energy efficiency services to allow for proper and efficient operation of equipment
- Heating Equipment Repair or Replacement Benefit: Repair or replace direct heating equipment needed to keep home's main heating source working
- Cooling Assistance: Buying and installing an AC unit or fan in home
- **5 Emergency HEAP Benefit:** Home cooling during heat or heat-related emergencies
